## What is this product?

### Type:

This product is an exchange traded product (non-interest bearing perpetual, fully collateralized debt instrument).

### Objectives:

The ETPs issued are non-equity linked securities replicating an actively managed digital assets investment strategy less a fee component. They do not bear interest and are not principal-protected. The value of the ETPs will depend on the performance of the actively managed portfolio of digital assets. The results are denominated in CHF, USD and EUR.

### Intended investor:


This product is intended for retail, professional and institutional investors in Switzerland, Liechtenstein, and the EU, who are prepared to take on a relatively high level of risk of loss to their original capital in order to get a higher potential return, and who plan to stay invested for at least 2 years. It is designed to form part of a portfolio of investments and it is not recommended that investors invest in this product more than what they are prepared to entirely lose.

### Maturity:

This product is open ended. However, the Issuer reserves the right to terminate and redeem the product, at the Issuer's sole discretion as well as in certain specified cases, in each case without any further prior consent of the investors, by publishing a Termination Notice (specifying the Redemption Date) in accordance with the Base Prospectus.

## What are the risks and what could I get in return?

### Risk Indicator



The risk indicator assumes you keep the product for 2 years. The actual risk can vary significantly if you cash in at an early stage and you may get back less.

The summary risk indicator is a guide to the level of risk of this product compared to other products. It shows how likely it is

that the product will lose money because of movements in the markets or market events, or because we are not able to pay you. We have classified this product as 7 out of 7, which is "the highest" risk class.
